This Advent season we invite you to reflect on Mary and Joseph's journey to Bethlehem through the experience of Elder Care Ministries' new labyrinth.

Walking a labyrinth is an ancient spiritual practice used by many different faiths for prayer and contemplation. The labyrinth represents a journey, a pilgrimage, an intentional time to seek God.

Our labyrinth will be available for individuals and groups of all ages from ABCORI congregations to walk at a time they select and at a pace that is meaningful for them. There will be labyrinth-related resources, along with several self-guided stations, to help participants reflect on the walk to Bethlehem.
